To whom it may concern,

I am writing to strongly object to the proposed 70 houses and a traveller site on the land at Golden Hill in Whitstable.

I am a resident living at [REDACTED], a very short distance from Golden Hill. I am a single parent to my two children, aged 14 and 11. My 14 year old has autism and extreme contamination ocd. For personal reasons, this proposal will be extremely detrimental to his mental health. We live in a very quiet and calm area, which he is used to. Adding additional houses and particularly a traveller site will undoubtedly cause much more noise, traffic and people. In addition, I am extremely concerned about the additional waste and rubbish which will affect his ocd hugely. A calm and quiet environment is vital to his wellbeing and it worries me that this will change.

In addition to the above, there will be issues for all residents. the road leading off Golden hill already becomes very congested during busy periods. Additional traffic will be very problematic. Pulling out of golden hill onto the old Thanet way is dangerous at times anyway, this proposal has the potential to cause serious road traffic accidents. Additional people will also mean more sewage, more water consumption and shortages, which is already at times an issue.

I would appreciate this to be given much more thought as to how it will affect local residents, as well as wildlife by taken away even more green spaces from the local area.
