I am writing as a resident of Tyler Hill to give feedback on the City Council's revisions to the Local Plan and, in particular, the decision to remove Policy C12 - the proposal to build 2000 houses on University of Kent land between Blean and Tyler Hill - from the Plan.

I am writing to applaud your decision and the reasons given for it, namely, the impact of the Policy C12 on the road network, the destruction of ancient woodland, and the costs and disruption involved the demolishing Blean Primary School, and rebuilding it elsewhere. These are very powerful objections to the Policy and formed the basis of much of the considerable public opposition to the proposal when it was first put out for consultation. I can thus see no reason for the City Council to reconsider, let alone revive, the proposal when the Local Plan is reviewed, and I feel confident, in the light of your earlier decision, that you will not do so.
