Dear CCC,

I am responding to the following question: Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of Land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)?

I whole-heartedly agree with the self-evident decision to delete C12 from the council's local development plans. I hope the council will continue to work with Save The Blean and other organisations to ensure a workable, sustainable alternative so the UKC does not destroy ancient woodlands and make the local road networks unusable.

I gather the demolition of Blean primary school has also been deemed to be a waste of money, so I see no plausible reason why the UKC and its development partner should be allowed to do irreversible damage to the environment and to blight the lives, and livelihoods, of local people as they are still hoping to do -- and that applies to any large-scale development they may propose in future.

The determination of locals to protect this unique land will not diminish over time, so I hope our strength will give you the confidence and fortitude to stand by your sensible and fair decision to delete C12 from local development plans.
