Dear Sirs,

I object to policies N20, N21, W4, and W6 because Whitstable's roads cannot cope with 2,106 more new homes without causing unacceptable impacts on highway safety. Recent planning applications suggest that the Council have not yet assessed all these problems and considered if adequate solutions are possible.

I object to draft Local Plan policy W4 Brooklands Farm and proposed A299 junction, because the new junction would trigger additional developments alongside the A299 New Thanet Way, causing yet more problems with traffic, water shortages and sewage pollution on our coastline.

Whitstable Heights on the Thanet way experienced faeces running down the streets during a storm some months ago because of poor infrastructure and blocked drains where Whitstable just can't cope with any more building. The buildings are ruining or lovely green land which are upsetting the people that have lived here for generations and the people who have moved here into houses that have been here for many years for a better life all because of government housing targets!
