I object to policies N20, w4, and w6 because Whitstable's roads cannot cope with so many more new homes without causing unacceptable highway safety problems. Recent planning applications suggest that the council have not adequately assessed these problems and considered whether suitable solutions are possible.

Also I specifically object to policy w4 Brooklands farm and proposed a 299 junction, because the new junction would trigger additional developments alongside the a299 new than it way causing even more problems with traffic, water shortage and sewage pollution on our coast.

The southern water authority has already admitted it cannot cope with existing flows. It has therefore invested in a pipeline into the sea so that illegal discharges can be made more frequently without being observed.

We are currently under a host pipe ban because of the shortage of supply for the current population levels. It takes years to develop additional clean water supply services and the speed and scale of developments should take this into account .

Health services are already under tremendous stress and I see little explanation as to how these will keep pace with the proposed developments.
