> I'm emailing to object to policies N20, W4 and W6 as I note the number of houses and flats now planned to be built in the Whitstable area has increased substantially. Whilst I appreciate the Council needs to meet arbitrary Government house building targets I am concerned about the impact of further increasing the numbers of new builds in this area of Kent. The increased amount of road traffic will lead to congestion on our local roads - already identified as being under pressure due to their construction. The number of new homes across all three sites will bring around eight to ten thousand more people to the Whitstable area. This will stretch current resources such as health services, schools, trains etc to breaking point. All these facilities should be increased/improved in line with the definite increased local population BEFORE construction of any new housing begins. I fully understand there is a need for new homes for the increasing demand but are these sites the best options? Unless facilities can meet the consequences of 8 - 10 thousand people coming to live here - then please reconsider.
