I am writing this to absolutely object to the above planning applications.

We keep objecting to all these planning applications because the infrastructure is not there, yet it seems to be ignored because all these planning applications get approved.

If someone does a calculation of all the houses that have been built in a three mile radius of Chestfield in the last 3 years, you are looking at around 6,000 houses! that means 12,000 more cars in such a small area, and that is not calculating the additional 1,350 houses that CCC want to build in Brooklands Farm. The area cannot cope with any more houses.

The objections, which are already well documented are:-

More cars, more traffic congestion, more pollution, more increased road accidents which puts more strain on the police, ambulances, and hospitals.

More people, less healthcare and dentists.

More crime, more vandalism, more thefts.

More flooding.

Loss of wildlife and green spaces.

More pollution into our sea, this will affect the tourism, less people will holiday here which will affect local businesses.
