I am responding to the question: Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)?

I am greatly relieved that the Policy C12 has been removed from the local plan. It would have destroyed large areas of irreplaceable ancient woodland and created a huge number of houses in the wrong location, accessible predominantly only by car thus placing an unsustainable impact on the already gridlocked local road network. Additionally, Canterbury parkrun, an important asset to Canterbury life, would have been lost.

The same objections would apply to any future proposal for a large development in that location, should the university sell the land to a developer.

I would like to thank the councillors for listening to the thousands of objectors to the proposal and removing it, hopefully permanently, from the local plan.
