Dear Sir/Madam,

I'm writing to objection to the building of a huge housing development on the Brooklands Farm site and the proposals for extra houses and Traveller at Chestfield.

Since I lived in this area 12 years or more...I have seen the destruction of our green spaces for housing estates. All the way along the Thanet way there are fresh developments as there are around Faversham. This madness has to be stopped for a whole list of reasons. Thousands of extra homes means a massive increase in local traffic and subsequent degradation of air quality. As someone who has to use my car for work I have noticed an increase in congestion locally and this plan will make that considerably worse.
