I lived through WW2 and remember the prefab bungalows from that time. They were quickly erected to provide housing for people who had lost their homes because of bombing. They answered the need at the time and endured for many years. I am sure that homeless people and youngsters still living at home would welcome one as a first step.

These proposed building projects are basically new towns and should be situated in areas which are large enough to accommodate all the infrastructure necessary at the start. More consideration should be given to the people who actually live in these areas now and are having to cope all the time with poorly maintained roads, constant traffic jams and problems with water and sewage. Their quality of life is being threatened by this constant demand for more houses.
