I wish to object the scale of this development This number of houses will lose vit green space from south Canterbury which s as breadth has little enough green space. The area is used by walkers and is criss crossed with footpaths. There will be a load of bio diversity The increase in traffic will impact on residential roads, it will be near Wincheap school thus increasing air pollution , noise, potential accidents on roads and impact on the Wincheap Allotments.
