I am writing to formally object to the proposed site allocations in the draft local plan regarding developments in Whitstable.

I find the plan to be unsound and unsustainable. My main concern is the collected impact these proposals will have on Whitstable & Chestfield's character and already strained resources.

I realise there are housing requirements for the district, but all I see is new builds within the area already and I cannot see any robust evidence to support the requirement for further development.

I feel the plan does not take into effect:

Infrastructure strain - on Schools / Health / road network

Environment -the pressure on water services in the area

Charater and sustainability - the proposed developments are way to big for the area and is therefore not sustainable

These objections refer to sites n20, n21, n23, n24
