Dear Planning Policy Team,

I am writing as a Whitstable resident to object to elements of the Local Plan Consultation 2025.

Objection summary

- I object to policies N20, W4 and W6 because Whitstable's roads cannot safely accommodate more new homes without causing unacceptable highway safety problems. Recent planning applications suggest the council has not adequately assessed these problems or considered whether suitable solutions are possible.
- I specifically object to Policy W4 (Brooklands Farm) and the proposed A299 junction. A new junction would likely trigger additional developments along the A299 New Thanet Way, leading to increased traffic, water shortage risk, and sewage pollution on our coast.
- The increase in health services, sewage pollution will be unprecedented and unmanageable!
- Put the funds going into this project into the SEWAGE issue!!!
Barbaric to allow a coastal town reliant on its sea to suffer in this way.
