Dear members of the Consultations Team of Canterbury City Council,

We are responding to the question “Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of Land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)?”

We live in Blean, on [REDACTED] to be precise and we are hugely impacted by the poor road network, road closures and traffic even when ‘small developments’ like the one of Ferham homes (which started this summer). We welcomed your deletion of Land north of UKC, policy C12, and are grateful you have listened to our concerns. We agree with the technical reasons given for the deletion those being - the impact on the road network, the destruction of the ancient woodland, and the cost effectiveness of demolishing the Blean primary school.
