Response to the question;

Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of land north of the university of Kent (Policy C12)?

I agree wholeheartedly with the deletion of policy C12. I believe that the technical arguments are sound, particularly the pressure on the area's fairly ancient road network and the inevitable complication of Blean school's demolition and replacement with what I suspect would be a sub-standard building built at the lowest possible cost and unsuitable as a long term proposition. Add to this the potential impact on the local countryside, precious wildlife and woodland, and I would say that the deletion makes perfect sense.

In my experience, developers' promises are rarely fulfilled over the course of a large development and the deletion of this policy will also send a warning to others considering similarly destructive proposals. Which of course I would also oppose.

I would like to congratulate the council on its deletion of policy C12 from its housing plans and I urge the councillors to ensure this deletion goes ahead. It is refreshing to live in an area where councils still listen to local residents, their consciences and above all common sense.
