My objections to the latest plans are quite simple:

1. WE HAVE NO WATER. South East Water cannot provide an adequate supply already and we have been on a hosepipe ban for months. The new reservoir in Broad Oak will not be operational for at least 10 years. NO further housing should go ahead until the problem has been resolved.
2. SEWAGE. The slightest shower means that our local coastline is flooded with sewage. I see no plans for a new sewage plant to be built to provide for the thousands of proposed houses.
3. CONGESTION. Obviously an upgrade to local roads is necessary - the road under the railway at Swalecliffe and bridge at Greenhill are totally not fit for purpose at the moment, resulting in frequent queues and accidents. Is this even being considered?

Please listen to the views of concerned residents before swamping our village with housing and ruining a beautiful area.
