Dear Sir/ Madam.

I am objecting to the planning application to build 150 houses on the Bread and Cheese field in Westbere.

These are the reasons:

Building houses on this field would coalesce the two villages of Hersden and Westbere.

This goes against the city council proposals to keep a green gap between existing villages.

150 houses are destined to be built which would destroy the heritage and integrity of Westbere. There are only 130 dwellings in Westbere. Your council recommends that no more than 10 to 15% new builds should occur in local service centres.

You seem to be over riding your own previous policies in local building.

Also, take into consideration:

Overloading an already totally turgid A28 with more vehicles from new householders.

Linear construction.

Decimation of even more countryside.

More building work is not needed or wanted here.
