Dear Sir or Madam,

My wife and I would like to formally log our opposition to the proposed further development of Bullockstone Road for the following reasons.

- 1) The Herne Bay area is already overcrowded and further development will only make matters worse by encouraging more outsiders to move in. We do not believe further development is necessary for local people. There are more than enough properties available already to suit local needs.
- 2) All roads are now very busy with Greenhill and Chestfield roundabouts now being dangerous at times when the traffic lights near their exits prevent vehicles from exiting them.
- 3) Bullockstone Road is now used as a main route from Herne Bay via the Greenhill roundabout to the Canterbury Road, is busy with heavy lorries thundering along it overhanging the center white line and damaging the grass verges and this pass a school where the road has no traffic calming measures in place. It is a wonder that no one has been hit.
- 4) Doctor's, dentist's, sewerage, fresh water supplies, schools etc. are already overstretched with no plans in place to increase the provision.
- 5) There are no jobs locally to support additional people.

We both feel the area has had sufficient development already and anything further will be extremely detrimental to the lives of your existing residents and hope therefore that you will log and take note of our comments.
