Regarding Local Plan, which includes removing policy C12 for the large development of 2,000 houses between Blean and Tyler Hill.

I am responding to the following question: Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of Land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)?
I hope that you will agree with the deletion of the policy C12 from the local plan.

I completely support the proposed deletion of Policy C12 because the technical reasons for the change, including the impact on the road network, the destruction of ancient woodland, and the cost of demolishing much needed Blean primary school, are valid. Why are the University of Kent still having a say over this? This will ultimately wipe out the whole of the Forest of Blean joining up Herne Bay with Canterbury, no woodland in between. This is absolutely unacceptable destruction and not consented to.
