I am responding to the question: "Do you have any comments on the proposed deletion of land north of the University of Kent (Policy C12)?"

I strongly support the deletion of the land north of the University of Kent from the local plan. The local road network is already over-capacity and the proposed development would drastically increase the volume of traffic, making the roads dangerously congested.

The proposed demolition of an Outstanding Primary School would be extremely damaging to local educational provision in the area as well as ruinously expensive.
