With reference to policy numbers N20, W4 and W6 under the local plan consultation 2025 we wish to register our objects to these ill thought out plans due to the following reasons: -

1. The lack of suitable medical facilities to sustain another 1,800 homes. It is well documented that it is almost impossible to get an appointment at the doctors.
2. Failure to provide sufficient drainage due to too many houses. Again it is well documented that our existing drainage cannot cope with the failure to keep the sea, rivers and streams and beaches clean.
3. The potential lack of sufficient drinking water. Southern Water are already concerned with this problem and with climate change this situation can only get worse with the proposed developments.
4. The provision of schools with the vast increase in children needing places. As most of the young children will need to attend Swalecliffe Primary School it is inevitable that the already heavily congested Herne Bay Road and the Chestfield roundabouts will finally grind to a halt.
5. The loss of much needed green belt land. This land should be used for food production, not houses. The council should be looking to develop brown field sites instead.
6. The potential of the provision of a new junction on the A299 will further cause inevitable further developments that the local infrastructure cannot cope with.

We trust you will take our objections above seriously and have second thoughts about these unnecessary plans.
