I am opposed to this plan because of the limited parking and increased traffic on the roads around the village which will be a risk to the safety of cyclists and pedestrians (particularly children). It is already impossible to get an appointment at Chartham Surgery and so residents are expected to travel to Northgate Surgery on the other side of Canterbury. The old school surgery will therefore be overwhelmed with patients who are not able to leave the village and travel elsewhere for their health needs to be met.

I also have concerns about the impact on the school and nurseries in the village. They already have no lollipop lady and consistent difficulties with safety outside the school during drop off and pick up times (where cars mount the pavement and buses, tractors can not get through).
