Dear Consultations Team,

I am writing to formally object to the new draft Local Plan (policies N20, N21, N22, N23 together with policy W4 Brooklands Farm).

The roads around and in Whitstable already become grid locked on a regular basis, before hundreds of further houses are built.

Sewage is a major problem, it often being unsafe to swim in the sea off Whitstable and especially after heavy rain. New housing will add to this environmental catastrophe.

Doctors are increasingly hard to access now.

Water shortages have been a huge issue, especially this summer. Bottled water was being issued to hundreds of houses earlier in the summer because of problems with the water supply. How will the water supply we need and pay for be maintained with all these extra houses?

Other issues - pollution from all the cars, loss of precious wildlife habitats, loss of the whole, historic, individual character of Whitstable, loss of quality of life for the residents, of safety and a healthy environment for children.

In addition to all this, a new junction with the A299 would give the go-ahead to many more developments.

These new proposals from the council are unrealistic and unsustainable. I request that these concerns are taken into consideration during the decision-making process.
