I object to the above policies (N20 ,W4 , W6) because Whitstable roads cannot cope with so many more new homes without causing additional unacceptable highway safety problems. Recent planning applications suggest that the council have not adequately assessed these issues and considered whether suitable solutions are possible.

I strongly object to Policy W4 Brooklands Farm and proposed A299 Junction, because this new Junction would trigger additional developments alongside the A299 new thanet way, causing even more traffic, sewage pollution and water shortages on our coast.

As is the current situation it is extremely difficult to get a doctor's appointment and impossible to get a dentist locally. Thousands of extra residents would have huge consequences on the facilities with which we require.

I do hope that our concerns are taken seriously and given the correct consideration.
