To whom it may concern,

Whilst I am in favour of the development of the brown field site at the Paper Mill in Chartham, I would like to express my opposition to the proposed greenfield site development off Rattington St. This seems wholly inappropriate, given the location of the site and the fact it is a greenfield site at all. This is a narrow road with some sharp turns and the presence of further houses on this road will only add to the considerable traffic already using the road and the resulting danger to road users and pedestrians. At the moment, a new site for homes is already being developed, closer to Canterbury, on the same road, though this seems to have been temporarily halted. However when this restarts, there will be even more traffic on this road. This is a road without a pavement and with very limited public transport providing access to it. I would ask you to consider other possible locations for houses in the Canterbury area.
