Dear Sirs

I wish to object to the altered local plan. The proposals will lead to increased traffic on already busy local roads. In the last 20 years local traffic has increase dramatically with the effect that at busy times there are long delays particularly at the Chestfield roundabout and railway bridge . This increased traffic has lead to an increase in road traffic accidents and a further 230 houses can only add to the traffic .. The Brooklands Farm proposal includes a link onto the New Thanet Way which will lead to the Chestfield Road becoming a 'rat run' .

The local infrastructure cannot always cope and there have been instances of flooding because drains have been overwhelmed .

The local schools are oversubscribed ,particularly Swale cliffs primary and junior school which now has over a thousand pupils and the traffic in the morning and evening is appalling and will only increase.

GP surgeries are increasingly busy and will had to cope with another 5000 patients if the Brooklands Farm proposal is allowed to proceed.

We have already lost a substantial amount of open land and more will go the the detriment of local residents and the environment.

Can the water companies cope with the increased demand. We already have a hosepipe ban , reservoirs are at record lows so again water shortages will only worsen if these plans go ahead.

I do not understand why there is a need for anther traveller site when we have a number in the area already .
