I write to raise my objections to the N32 development. Having moved to Chartham in 2001 we have seen many changes in the village due to increasing development over the period we have lived here.

Our main objections are,

GPs surgeries already cannot cope with the demand from the current residents.

Loss of agricultural land and wildlife habit.

Increased traffic causing noise, pollution and danger from speeding vehicles. We live on [REDACTED] and lost our cat due to a speeding vehicle using Bolts Hill as a cut through to Shalmsford Street, within 2 weeks 3 other cats had been killed on the same part of the road due to high volume of traffic. Many young children walk or ride to the local school using these roads and the amount of traffic now using the roads, which they weren't built for, is a huge concern for us.
