Objection to Policy N3 - Thanington Recreation Ground

Dear Planning Policy Team,

I am writing to object to Policy N3 in the draft Local Plan, which proposes development on Thanington Recreation Ground.

This green space is vital to local residents' health, wellbeing, and community life. It is a much-loved public park, used daily for recreation and social activities, and is closely linked to the Thanington Neighbourhood Resource Centre, which relies on the space for outdoor programmes and accessibility.

The proposed loss of the Recreation Ground is not justified, and no equivalent replacement has been identified. This contradicts national planning policy and the Council's own commitments to health, equality, and green infrastructure.

The residents of Thanington must not lose this green space and with the concern over the Resource Centres future if the building work goes ahead, it is out of the question to take this from the residence, especially the children of this under resourced area.

Please remove Policy N3 from the Local Plan, and instead protect Thanington Recreation Ground as a designated open space.
