I have responded to the Consultation Questionnaire **Our Future District 2040** on behalf of the Canterbury SDG Forum (UN Sustainable Development Goals).

As you will see from the attached **Additional Submission**, we have felt the need to add to those responses with greater detail. This is especially true in relation to the preamble to the questionnaire, which did not allow for this level of explanation. I also attach a copy of the **Outline Responses** themselves, as these were written as a comprehensive paper that I then edited into your formatted questionnaire.

You will see a reference to previous contact that we have had with Mr Carmichael, Councillors and Officers over the past 2.5 years. These included a useful symposium in November 2018 with an officer of Sint Truiden Municipality in Belgium, explaining their 2 year project to engage their local populations and their local governments in addressing the UN's Sustainable Development Goals with their people and within their policies. As suggested in our response we do hope to be able to work with the City Council further, as it develops its Local Plan.
