Last year many of you told us about the key issues and challenges facing the district as we embarked on our review of the Local Plan - the council's formal planning blueprint that allocates land for homes, jobs, community use and open space

We received more than 9,000 comments from almost 500 people and organisations and were incredibly grateful for people taking the time to get in touch.

We have used that feedback to create a draft vision for the district and come up with options for how it could grow and change in the future.

We want to know what you think about these options, including:
