Re - New local Plan 2040

I attended last night's meeting 26th July at the Harbledown Parish Council in vain hope that details of a suggestion of the 4th Park & Ride on Wingate Hill, Upper Harbledown would be revealed. The only information the meeting learned was some City councillor had initiated contact with Jackson Engineering noted for Park and Rides.

Regardless of the absence of detailed plans and information, I wish to register strong objections to the concept of a 4 Park and Ride for Canterbury in Upper Harbledown.

A few years ago the Parish Council backed at great expense and much effort a very comprehensive and thorough review of proposals to create a Park and Ride on the land behind Faulkners Lane.

This was rejected outright, the proposal with the outcome that the City Council dropped the idea completely and that it would never be raised again. I see no reason whatever to resurrect the idea this time in Upper Harbledown.

I would ask you to delete such plan from New local Plan 2040. This view was expressed by all attendees the Meeting. Yours faithfully,
