- As residents of Womenswold, we strongly object to the proposed CCC District Plan plan for up to 17000 new houses.
The urban sprawl from Aylesham will seriously impact the environment and villages outside, like Womenswold, are in danger of losing their identity. Many residents in most surrounding villages feel nervous about these proposals. Is this part of an already crowded part of the country to become an enormous building site?

The urbanisation of such a huge area of land will seriously reduce the land area for food production (arable & livestock), recreation (walkways, bridle paths) and reduce environmental protection and biodiversity opportunities.
