Dear Planning

I note on page 19 of the Jacobs Transport Modelling Report that there is a proposal to increase spaces at the Wincheap Park & Ride by 300 spaces. I can find no information specifying how this would be done and no scheme layout (contrary to the statement on page 19 of the report that 'Scheme layouts are included in Appendix A and B'). It is, therefore, impossible to comment in a detailed way. However, I would like to emphasise that any proposal to use Wincheap Water Meadows for the expansion of the Park & Ride would once again meet with intense opposition due to its impact on the natural environment. Any proposal to increase the size of the Wincheap Park & Ride must either focus on the construction of a multi-storey on the existing footprint of the car park or on the use of neighbouring brownfield land.
