I would like make my objections known about the proposed development of housing and planned expansion of Aylesham to double its size up to the villages of Womenswold, Snowdown and Woolage Village, as part of the Local Plan that would include 17,000 new homes.

This proposed housing covers large fields, and would destroy a number of ancient woodlands and historic footpaths.

It would affect local wildlife habitats which include game birds, birds of prey, hedgehog and fox populations to name a few.

It would cause an increase in road use on small country lanes not designed for the expected volume of traffic.

It would put further strain on health, education and infrastructure in general.

We already have an issue with speeding motorists and heavy goods vehicles tearing up the roads in our villages.

I do not want urban sprawl venturing out to the countryside where we choose to live in peace and have areas containing natural beauty.

This proposed development must not go ahead.

I am happy to do what I can to protest against this potential expansion of this particular site.

The village residents are currently creating a signed petition, and the local Councillor and parish Council all agree with objecting this proposal.
