I spent much of yesterday trying to access the consultation document on the above plan but to no avail. I understand from friends and acquaintances that this has been a common occurrence and I have to say, I consider it monstrous that the CCC website is so poorly organised that it cannot be easily accessed by residents.

My husband, Michael Woods, my son, Tom Harvey and I are very much against this development, particularly as it would appear to be linked with the previously proposed Park and Ride in Harbledown at Faulkners Lane on prime agricultural land and, I suspect, the development of more housing. None of these projects make any sense in this time when we should be building cycle paths and developing public transport instead of making provision for more and more polluting vehicles and building houses which the current sewage system will be unable to handle and will eventually cause more and more flooding.

I feel extremely frustrated by the fact that the City Council has made it impossible to reach the consultation document and I have been unable to complete it by the closing date tomorrow.

I hope that in future the City Council will improve these matters.
