- Your message Please forward the following text to those considering responses to the Council's preferred options for the 2040 Local Plan: Canterbury District Green Party doesn't consider a meaningful response can be made to the consultation in the current format. We have therefore written a brief text with the key points we would like to make about the preferred options. We would be grateful if you would give them your attention. Canterbury District Green Party is pleased to see that the Council has commissioned a large number of studies to accompany its preferred options for the Local Plan up to 2040. This is especially true of the Sustainability Appraisal, which clearly lays out the negative effects for our environment involved in any growth and development. Rather than accepting developers' plans for new unaffordable housing on green fields – fields which will be needed in the not-so-distant future for food production – we would like to see a serious commitment to bringing empty buildings back into use in the District and to any extra building required being on brownfield sites, such as the Wincheap industrial estate, with all building adhering to zero-carbon standards. We would want a recognition that addressing the climate emergency, traffic congestion and the associated air pollution so harmful to public health requires far more action on the part of the Council to bring about modal shift from the private car to public transport, cycling and walking. Until public transport is far cheaper, faster and more convenient than taking a car, this shift will simply not happen. It certainly won't happen if new roads like the proposed bypass (with its eye-watering condition of 17,000 extra houses) are built, which all research shows will counteract any positive effect by quickly causing further increases in traffic. Many of the Council's preferred options make the right noises, but will need to be backed up with significant changes to current policies to enable the District to meet the huge challenges which lie ahead when the climate emergency will be affecting our world with even graver consequences than it is at the moment.
