I live in Womenswold and would like to register my objection to the proposed expansion of Aylesham. There are a total lack of amenities to support such an expansion; the roads are narrow and traffic is congested as it is. There will be little local employment for such an expansion and totally inadequate public transport or schools and leisure facilities. The proposal would be a wanton erosion of green belt and an AONB

The area would not be able to support the horrors of the 17,000 homes proposed within the plan, but there is a brown field site at the old colliery at Snowdon that should be considered first

The plans take no account of the limited infrastructure - already overstretched with the current growth to Aylesham

They are poorly thought out in an area which simply cannot take the expansion envisaged and as such should be dropped and withdrawn
