I write on behalf of the Ickham, Littlebourne and Wickhambreaux Conservation Society. We find the on-line Consultation a difficult medium in which to express a coherent view.

We wish to make the following observations:

We find the idea of building a further 17,000 more homes, additional to the 9000 suggested by government, in order to fund a by-pass, an incomprehensibly foolish suggestion. All the extra vehicles this would produce will cause more pollution and not in the long term relieve the pressure on the ring road. There will be an increase in local journeys.

The infrastructure in East Kent, roads, drainage, medical services are already overstretched.

Canterbury should be resisting government pressure to build more, and work to preserve the environment and conserve farming land for food production.
