The last report and technical appendices that I reviewed (Greenshank_ODG_Stodmarsh Stream Enhancement Scheme Main Report & Technical Appendices V3, 18/07/2025) had the following calculated nutrient removal loads:

- Hinxhill_DD1- 1114.701kg N/yr, 63.8 kg P/yr
- Hinxhill_DD2 – 637.33 kg N/yr, 31.50 kg P/yr
- Wilmington_DD1 – 89.56 kg N/yr, 4.61 kg P/yr
- Wye_DD1 – 807.54 kg N/yr, 35.13 kg P/yr
- South_hill_DD1 – 470.27 kg N/yr, 21.43 kg P/yr
- Bilby_wood_DD1 – 2491.19 kg N/yr, 106.43 kg P/yr
- Bilby-wood_DD2 – 815.95 kg N/yr, 40.79 kg P/yr

They seem to match to figures produced by Ollie.
